How to connect to a Power BI content pack

Power BI – Basic Authentication

- Find the Dynamics 365 Business Central or Dynamics NAV content pack you want to connect to from the Power BI Services library
- 2. Select 'Get it Now'
- 3. Enter the connection URL. This would be any of the URLs listed in the 'Web Services' Page.

Example:

https://mod853593.financials.dynamics.com:7048/MS/ODataV4/Company('CRONUS%20US')

- 4. Choose Basic Auth for authorization type
- 5. Enter User Name
- 6. Enter Password or Web Access Key
- 7. Select 'Next'

Note: Basic authentication type will require an open port and self signed certificates to connect if using Dynamics NAV or Business Central on premises.

Power BI – Azure Active Directory

- Find the Dynamics 365 for Finance and Operations content pack you want to connect to from the Power BI Services library
- 2. Select 'Get it Now'
- 3. Select 'Create' connection
- 4. Enter your Azure (Office 365) credentials
